DID YOU KNOW that there is a public, year-round (50 weeks a year), elementary school (K-8) in the city of Orange for children living in *transitional housing*?

Operated by the Orange County Department of Education, **Project HOPE School** offers small class sizes and therefore, more individualized instruction.

Additional **FREE** benefits of **HOPE School**:

- **Transportation** to and from school
- **Breakfast and lunch** each day
- **After school care** at the Tustin Boys and Girls Club until 5pm
- **Counseling services**, if necessary
- **Life skills groups** (conflict management, safe dating, college preparation)
- **Weekly food backpack** program
- **Food and hygiene product pantry**
- **Enrichment programs**: Instrumental music, art, drama
